During our Prayer & Praise meeting last week, the Lord dropped a phrase into my heart as we prayed in small groups: humility and hunger. I was prompted to intercede accordingly for the Cathedral community: that we would seek the Lord with both humility and hunger, and that this would consistently be our posture before Him. Regular participation in corporate intercession is an apt way to demonstrate this. As we come together in prayer, we acknowledge both our dependence on God and our desire for more of Him.

Many of us have been praying for the Holy Spirit to bring about a fresh work of spiritual renewal in our midst. (If you haven't been doing so, you should!) Every significant spiritual revival in history has been preceded by genuine repentance, with God's people crying out for more of Him, confessing that "we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned—every one—to his own way" (Isaiah 53:6). The phrase "humility and hunger" is an invitation for us to get right with God and give Him His rightful place.

Praying for humility and hunger must be "active". It begins with seeking God on our knees, but it doesn't end there. Rather, we should maintain this posture before God as we go about our daily business. Eugene Peterson

paraphrases Romans 12:1-2 as follows: "So here's what I want you to do, God helping you: Take your everyday, ordinary life—your sleeping, eating, going-to-work, and walking-around life—and place it before God as an offering. Embracing what God does for you is the best thing you can do for him. Don't become so well-adjusted to your culture that you fit into it without even thinking. Instead, fix your attention on God. You'll be changed from the inside out. Readily recognise what he wants from you, and quickly respond to it. Unlike the culture around you, always dragging you down to its level of immaturity, God brings the best out of you, develops well-formed maturity in you."

"God helping you", "what God does for you", "God brings the best out of you". It's not about what we can do, but what He can do. To be spiritually hungry is to zealously take hold of that which God graciously offers to us. If each one of us faithfully practises this in our daily living, the spiritual renewal we yearn for will not be far away.

THE WORLD

Pray for Nepal following the devastating flash floods and landslides that have taken many lives and left thousands missing. Pray for the rescue teams working in difficult conditions, that they will be able to reach those who are still trapped or stranded, and for humanitarian aid to be organised and delivered quickly to the communities most affected. Pray that God will protect those in danger and prevent further flooding and loss of life. May God draw near to the people of Nepal in their grief and uncertainty. May He comfort those who have lost loved ones, sustain those who are waiting anxiously for news, and strengthen all who are working to bring help and relief. May His peace and grace uphold the nation through this time of great suffering.

SINGAPORE

Pray for families in Singapore, especially young couples and parents who are building their families while balancing the demands of work and caring for their children. Pray that the Lord will give them wisdom, strength and joy as they raise the next generation, and provide for those who may be struggling with the pressures and financial costs of family life. Pray especially for Christian families, that they will hold firmly to their faith amid the competing demands on their time and resources. Pray for grandparents, that they will be a source of encouragement and support to their children and grandchildren, and faithfully uphold their families in prayer. May our Christian faith be a firm foundation in our city, beginning in our homes and families, so that the next generation will know and follow the Lord.

DIOCESE

For the Chapel of the Holy Spirit, pray for the Vicar Revd Joseph You and his team as they seek God's direction for 2027-2029, guided by the overarching theme "Abiding in Christ Together". Pray that God breathe new life into the members as they reflect on His word in Ezekiel 37; that the Lord raise up a mighty army for His Kingdom, who are equipped, united and empowered by the Holy Spirit.
