PRAYER HIGHLIGHTS



THE WORLD

We pray for Indonesia following the eruption of Mount Anak Krakatau. May the Lord watch over communities affected by volcanic ash and disruption, and grant wisdom to those monitoring the volcano and responding to the needs of people whose daily lives and livelihoods have been affected. We also remember those living near Mount Sinabung, asking that the Lord watch over them and keep them safe. We continue to pray for Nepal following the devastating floods and landslides. We ask the Lord to sustain search and rescue teams as they continue looking for those still missing, and to give strength and courage to those who remain trapped or are awaiting news of their loved ones. May the Lord provide for communities in greatest need, and guide the provision of food, clean water, shelter and medical care. We remember before Him those who are grieving, and all who are working to bring help and healing.

SINGAPORE

We pray for Singapore and our region as the haze continues to affect our skies and air quality. We ask for the Lord's mercy and protection from its harmful effects, especially for the elderly, the young, and those who are most vulnerable. We pray also for our neighbouring countries and communities affected by the haze, that the Lord will watch over them and sustain them through this season. May we remember that the Lord is the Maker of heaven and earth, sovereign over His creation, and place our trust in Him for the things beyond our control.

DIOCESE

For Holy Trinity Church, we pray that members will be enriched through the cell group ministry and that they will continue to grow deeper in intimacy with God and in fellowship with one another. Pray that the Senior Fellowship will be a good platform for elderly members to interact and to grow together in their faith journey, through this season of their lives. Pray also for good response to the Mid-Autumn Carnival and for a mighty harvest of souls through this community outreach.

For Light of Christ Church Woodlands, we pray that God will richly provide for all their needs; that members across all 4 congregations will rise up to be God-fearing leaders. Pray that the church will bear much fruit in her School Ministry, Tuition Programme and Anglican Senior Centre Woodlands, and for more tuition mentors for their Tuition Programme. Thank God that more students and parents from the schools are joining the church services.

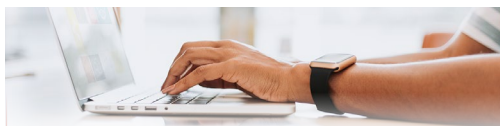
