THE WORLD

Pray that world leaders and frontier artificial intelligence companies will heed the call by UN High Commissioner for Human Rights Volker Türk, to act urgently, to rein in the development of super powerful AI systems, which could cause irreversible change and threaten human existence for generations to come. Pray that all parties involved will put aside their rivalries for the common good; that they will recognise the need to chart a path for action to govern advanced, frontier AI models; that governments and AI developers will establish strict regulations and continuous safety testing, to ensure that human rights remain at the forefront of the technology, and avoid harmful, runaway AI scenarios that override human control. Pray that our God-given creativity will always be submitted to His moral compass in every aspect of our lives.

SINGAPORE

We thank God for Singapore's multiracialism and multiculturalism and pray for divine protection from potential threats that could tear our social fabric apart. Pray that Singaporeans will remain a cohesive society where there is mutual respect for people of different races, languages and religions, who are united by a shared purpose and a common destiny. Pray that we will not allow any prejudices or stereotypes to shape our social norms and that we will be open to learning from those who are different from us. Pray that every Singaporean, regardless of how or when they became citizens, will feel a sense of belonging to this nation and that together we may build a vibrant and harmonious Singapore for ourselves and all future generations.

DIOCESE

For St John's Chapel, pray that members will be knit together in love and in His Kingdom's purpose. May they be strengthened in the faith, reignited with passion for God and united in mission, to serve God and to glorify His Name.

For St Paul's Church, pray that the youth and young adult ministries will be vibrant platforms for spiritual growth and for raising up the next generation of leaders. Pray that seniors will be valued; that their wealth of experience and spiritual gifts will be mightily used in the service of God. Pray that the church will be warm and welcoming to residents in the Kovan/Hougang community and that God will bless their outreach efforts to this community with fruitfulness.

Impact on Worship Services

The 4.30pm Worship Services will **NOT** be in session on 11 Oct (Sun). There will only be Worship Services in Mandarin on 11 Oct at 9:30am and 11:30am, and in Hokkien at 11:30am. The Worship Service in Cantonese will **NOT** be in session. All other Worship Services will carry on as usual.

During these operating hours, vehicles may enter St Andrew's Cathedral only via North Bridge Road, and exit only via the Coleman Street/ North Bridge Road junction. The pedestrian gate beside City Hall MRT Exit B will be open.

DIOCESAN EDUCATION MONTH

Every September, the Diocese of Singapore remembers our Education Mission. The Anglican Church serves 3 primary schools, 5 secondary schools and 1 junior college as well as 2 schools for children with special needs. The Education Mission Fund (EMF) was set up with the bequest of Mr Tan Lye Whatt, a former Principal of St Andrew's School, with the intention to support and strengthen school chaplaincy work. The EMF is used to subsidise the hiring and/or training costs of chaplaincy workers.
